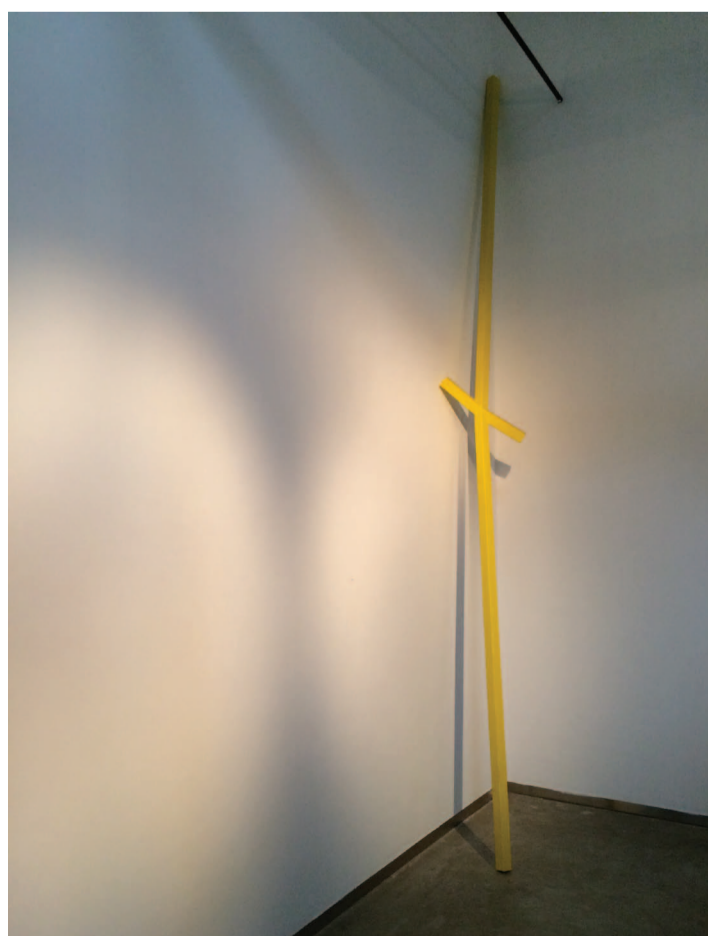


New acquisitions by three Dutch Museums
